#### The PMUG Local Environment Award

Japanese Society of Geo-pollution Science, Medical Geology and Urban Geology (PMUG)

This award aims to recognize and support outstanding but not-well-recognized achievements that contribute significantly to environmental stewardship and sustainability of local communities. It is awarded annually and consists of a certificate.

### **Nomination Guidelines**

## 1. Entry Criteria

The span of activities for which nominations can be made is wide and includes all disciplines which have relevance to the local environment.

### 2. Procedure

Nominations must include the following through PMUG's homepage. When not feasible, please contact the secretariat rokusanbkk@gmail.com.

### (1) A short statement of motivation

Submit a detailed description of the activity the nominee has conducted and how it contributes to environmental issues around local communities. Main achievements and their importance should be emphasized.

(2) Attach a CV or/and Biography of the nominee and materials such as press articles or web links if available

# (3) Attach a letter of reference

A letter of reference should be written by someone other than the nominator. It can be submitted either in Japanese or in English using the official form available at the website. Please note that self-nominations are not accepted.

# 3. Evaluation process

The Award Committee reviews the nominations and decides the awardee by discussing with the president and vice-president of the PMUG. The decision is made public when the PMUG holds the annual symposium. The discussion of the evaluation is not disclosed.
